**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 146
A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SACKVILLE RESPECTING THE
WATER AND SEWERAGE SYSTEMS**

Pursuant to sections 7(1) and 7(3) of the Municipalities Act, Chapter M-22 the Council of the Municipality of Sackville duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

The Council of the Municipality of Sackville duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-Law No. 146, A By-Law of the Municipality of Sackville Respecting the Water and Sewerage Systems, is amended by deleting section 15(5)(c)(ii), 15(9), and 50(4)(c)(ii) and substituting thereof the following:

Section 15(5)(c)(ii) will now read as follows:

For metered users, the service charge shall be computed semi-annually and levied semi-annually for the half year ending on or about June 30th and the half year ending on or about December 31st.

Section 15(9) will now read as follows:

Where water is supplied to a user through a water meter, the prescribed per unit volume rate shall apply and may be amended at any time by Resolution of Council. In any case, a minimum of 60 cubic meters (13,200 gallons) per half year shall be charged as a base rate, but that the rate table in sub-section 15(10) shall apply. The Town or its agents shall have the right to inspect and read meters any time during normal hours of business.

Section 50(4)(c)(ii) will now read as follows:

For metered users, the service charge shall be computed semi-annually and levied semi-annually for the half year ending on or about June 30th and the half year ending on or about December 31st.

2. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on July 1, 1998.

Read a first time this 14th day of April, 1998.

Read a second time this 14th day of April, 1998.

Read a third time and passed Council this 28th day of April, 1998.
