

BY-LAW NO. 154
A BY-LAW REGULATING THE
DUTIES OF THE FIRE CHIEF

The Council of the Town of Sackville, under authority vested in it by Section 109 (1) (a) and 74 (5) of the Municipalities Act, enact as follows:

1. The Chief of the Fire Department shall, under the direction of the Liaison Councillor for Public Safety;
 - a) Have direct control of the duties, department and training of all staff in the Fire Department;
 - b) Have the direct responsibility for the efficiency and operations of the Fire Department and the Firefighters;
 - c) Recommend such policies or practices, improvements and changes which from time to time will improve the fire protection of the Town and he shall promptly carry out all policies, practices, improvements or changes approved by the Chief Administrative Officer or the Council;
 - d) Be responsible for the operation of the Fire Department, through the policies, directives and By-Laws of the Town of Sackville and applicable Provincial and Federal statutes; and
 - e) Other duties that may be assigned from time to time by the Chief Administrative Officer.

2. It is hereby agreed and understood that wherever in these presents the masculine gender is used it shall be deemed to be and shall be as the feminine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires; and the feminine gender shall be deemed to be and shall be at the masculine gender or neuter genders if the context so requires.


3. By-Law No. 118, A By-Law Regulating The Duties of The Fire Chief is hereby repealed.
