

BY-LAW NO. 1

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE ADOPTION AND
INTERPRETATION OF THE TOWN SEAL.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Sackville enact as follows;

1. The Common Seal of the Town of Sackville representing a globe, an open book, ship under full sail, a stove and a plow with the words "Act of 1896" circumscribed by an inner circle and the words "The Town of Sackville, N. B. Incorporated January 1903" circumscribed by an outer circle, an impression of which Seal appears on the margin of the By-Law shall be, and is hereby declared to be, the Corporate Seal of the Town of Sackville.
2. The Town Clerk shall have custody of the Common Seal of the Town.
3. The Town Clerk shall, in the presence of the Mayor, affix the Common Seal to all documents requiring the same and made, granted or issued by the authority of the Council.
4. Where the Common Seal is required solely for the purpose of authenticating the signature of the Clerk, the Clerk may affix the seal without the presence or authority of any other person or body.
