

BY-LAW NO. 73
A BY-LAW TO REGULATE PEDESTRIAN USE OF BRIDGES

WHEREAS there have been a number a relatively serious incidents involving pedestrians on bridges in the Town of Sackville;

AND WHEREAS it is desirous by the members of the Council to ensure the safety of the citizens of this community and those that visit;

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Sackville enacts as follows:

1. All bridges located within the municipal bounds of the Town of Sackville are for the use of vehicular traffic and direct pedestrian crossing and for no other purpose.
2. Any person who loiters on, plays on, or remains on the bridge for any purpose other than being there for the direct passage from one end of that bridge to the other is in violation of this by-law.
3. Any person who is in contravention of this by-law is liable to a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$25.00 for the first offense and on any subsequent offense is liable to punishment of not less than a fine of \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.

Read a second time this 12th day of September, 1983.

Read a third time and done and passed Council this 12th day of September, 1983.
