

**BY- LAW NO. 73A**  
**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 73,**  
**A BY- LAW TO REGULATE PEDESTRIAN USE OF BRIDGES**

The Council of the Town of Sackville, under authority vested in it by the *Municipalities Act* of New Brunswick, Chapter M-22, R.S.N.B. (1973), hereby enacts as follows:

Section 3 will now read as follows:

3. Any person who is in contravention of this by-law is guilty of a fine of not less than \$50 and not more than \$500. All such fines shall be recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Procedures Act*, S.N.B. 1987, c.P-22.1.

This By-Law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.

Read a second time this 13<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2015.

Read a third time and done and passed Council this 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2015.
