

Registration of Undertaking Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation Clean Environment Act

Opportunity for Public Comment

On September 21st, 2017, the Town of Sackville registered the following project with the N.B. Department of the Environment and Local Government (NBDELG) in accordance with Section 5(1) and Schedule "A" of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation: Lorne Street Reconstruction and Storm Water Mitigation Phase 2.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct two (2) stormwater retention ponds, a new Aboiteau structure, including a new discharge channel to store and transport stormwater flows that would normally flood the Lorne Street area and redirect them to the Tantramar River. The project is located on properties within the Town of Sackville, on a flood plain, between Lorne Street and the Tantramar River.
