



2018 “Sackville Fall Fair Anything That Floats Race” Rules

1. The first rule is to be safe and have fun.
2. The registration fee is \$10 per team. **Register early** as only 20 teams will be accepted. Entry forms available at: Middle Sackville Variety, Town Hall, sackville.com/fallfair, Middle Sackville Baptist Church and at middlesackvillebaptist.org.
3. Race date is **Sunday, September 23, 2018 starting at 2 pm**. Check in at Lillas Fawcett Park at 1:30 pm.
4. Properly sized and in good condition: Coast Guard approved “personal floatation devices” (PFD's, life jackets or vests) must be worn during the race. Race organizers will not provide safety equipment.
5. This is a timed race, with a minimum 2 boats racing at a time. The race will begin at the beach and continue around a buoy and back to the beach.
6. Teams must consist of 2 to 4 members with a minimum of one adult per team. All participants must be 5 years of age or older. The entire crew must sign an acknowledgement of risk form. Participants under 18 must have a signed release from a parent or guardian.
7. All participants must be contained within their vessel. Swimming alongside is not permitted. The vessel must sail a 100-meter course. Participants must be able to take the blame when losing or sinking.
8. Boats must be homemade vessels made of materials that you could find around your house. **Permitted materials:** cardboard, wood, pvc, duct tape, milk jugs, saran wrap, old t-shirts, outdoor furniture, pool noodles, and old bikes. Oars, paddles and sails are allowed (hence the t-shirts) and pedal power is OK. **Not permitted:** motors of any kind, polystyrene foam, inflatable rafts, pool toys, commercially designed watercraft. Judges reserve the right to refuse any vessel. All vessels must be powered by human energy.
There may be some helpful materials available. Please call 536-9109 if you're interested in them. You will be asked to sign for them and to return them.
9. The race is rain or shine! Cancellation will only be due to severe or dangerous weather conditions.
10. Boat Captains are responsible for the proper salvage and disposal of your craft after the race. Vessels may remain onsite after the event is finished.
11. The Town of Sackville and Middle Sackville Baptist Church are not liable for any injuries sustained by any participants during this event.
12. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: Fastest Vessel, Most Creative Design, and Best Use of Fall Fair Theme – ***For the Health of It!***
