BY-LAW NO. 262B A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 262 A BY-LAW TO REGULATE STREET TRAFFIC

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Sackville enacts as follows:

Section 6 of By-Law No. 262 – A By-Law to Regulate Street Traffic is amended to read as follows:

1 NON-VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

- No person shall ride or operate roller blades, skateboards or bicycles on any sidewalks within the Town of Sackville.
- 6.2 No person shall ride or operated a bicycle or a skateboard on any street within the Town of Sackville unless the person is at all times wearing a helmet which conforms to the current standards established by Regulation under the *Motor Vehicle Act* (New Brunswick) with the chinstrap securely fastened under the person's chin.
- 6.3 No parent or guardian of a person who is under sixteen (16) years of age shall authorize or knowingly permit that person to ride on or operate a bicycle or a skateboard on any street within the Town of Sackville unless the person is wearing a helmet in accordance with Section 6.2
- 6.4 Every person who is riding or operating a bicycle or a skateboard shall at all times:
 - (a) exercise due care and attention to their safety and the safety of others; and
 - (b) travel in a manner and at a speed appropriate to the surface being travelled upon.
- No person shall ride or operate a bicycle or a skateboard in such a manner so as to cause any damage to public or private property.
- 6.6 Any person riding or operating a skateboard shall:
 - (a) at all times between dusk and dawn wear reflective materials that are clearly visible from both the front and back of the person;
 - (b) travel in a straight line as close as is practicable to the righthand side of the street; and
 - (c) at all times yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and cyclists.
- 6.7 While riding or operating a skateboard on any street within the Town of Sackville no person shall:
 - (a) vault from a ramp or other object;

- (b) use any object to move over, under, on, in or around with a skateboard for a recreational purpose;
- (c) dismount from a skateboard in an unsafe manner;
- (d) ride or operate the skateboard in such a manner as to permit it or cause it to leave the ground;
- (e) move erratically from side-to-side;
- (f) race; or
- (g) slide their skateboard.

This By-Law	comes into	force on	the date	of final	passing	thereof.
