

Nature Trails

Sackville Waterfowl Park

This award-winning 55-acre park features 3.5 kms of accessible walking trails and boardwalks, including a section of the Trans-Canada trail (The Great Trail). Just minutes from the highway and a short walk from downtown, visitors have spotted 60 bird species (including 26 confirmed breeding species), and 200 species of plants.

Guided tours are offered May to August, or you can pick up a self-guided tour map from the Visitor Information Centre at the end of Mallard Drive.



The Great Trail

A multi-use recreational trail built on a former rail bed. From Sackville you can walk or cycle 33 km to a working fishing wharf in Port Elgin, and continue to Cape Tormentine, Cape Jourimain, and the Confederation Bridge.
