- C. Nomination must have the consent of the nominee, or if deceased, the family.
- D. Nominee may be active or retired at the time of nomination.
- E. The Selection Board and / or Sackville Arts Wall Committee reserves the right to research any application to verify the accuracy of the information provided.
- F. If space is insufficient, please attach additional sheets and label accordingly.
- G. The following information must be completed accurately and fully.
