

🗘 Green Bags (Organics): Collected every week.

#### **Bulky Item Collection**


No more spring and fall clean-ups. Instead, you can now place 1 bulky item out for pickup on CLEAR BAG collection weeks.

# Public Art Restorations: "Heron's Watch" and the George Stanley Statue Return



Two of Tantramar's beloved public sculptures have been restored and are once again ready to be enjoyed by the community.

Sculptor **Christian Toth** recently completed repairs to both **"Heron's Watch"** and the **statue of George Stanley**, bringing renewed life to these important public pieces.

Originally installed in **2016** at the corner of **Bridge and Weldon Streets**, "Heron's Watch" features a family of bronze birds—**Aaron the Heron**, and ducks **Willie and Grace Annie**. After some wear and unexpected disappearance of one of the birds, the sculpture has now been **repaired and reinforced**, ensuring it remains a whimsical and meaningful part of our downtown streetscape.

Meanwhile, the **bronze statue of George Stanley**—renowned designer of the National Flag of Canada and long-time Sackville resident has also been carefully

restored to match the original bronze finish, reaffirming our commitment to preserving local heritage.

These restorations not only maintain the beauty of our public spaces but also reflect Tantramar's pride in local art, history, and storytelling.





## **Council Updates**

#### Council Highlights - Special Meeting of Council - July 28, 2025

Council Highlights provide a brief overview of the latest Special Meeting of Council. For complete details, please refer to the official minutes, which will be available once approved at the next Regular Council Meeting.

Special Meetings of Council are held as needed to move forward on time-sensitive initiatives. Below is a snapshot of the key discussions and decisions made at this meeting.

### **Council Package**

### **Recreation and Community Development**

- Tantramar Recreation Master Plan Council approved the development of
  Tantramar's first-ever Recreation Master Plan, a major step forward for long-term
  recreation planning under our 2025-2028 Strategic Plan. The plan will be led by RC
  Strategies and will guide how the municipality supports recreation access,
  programming, and facilities across the region.
- Mount Allison Orientation Fireworks Council authorized the Sackville Fire Chief to sign off on a fireworks permit for Mount Allison University Orientation Week, allowing a short display at Park Street Soccer Field. This supports the ongoing partnership between the municipality and the university.
- TVMCC Canteen Contract Renewal Heather Wells was awarded a two-year contract extension to continue providing canteen services at the Tantramar Veterans Memorial Civic Centre, supporting local business and enhancing community experience at the facility.

Fort Beauséjour – Acadian Day Celebration – Council approved a Special Activity
License with Parks Canada to host the municipality's Acadian Day Celebration at
Fort Beauséjour – Fort Cumberland National Historic Site on August 14, 2025. We
invite all our residents to enjoy Acadian Day Celebrations with us this year at Fort
Beauséjour!

#### **Policy and Governance**

**Corporate Planning** – Council approved the retention of **Strategic Steps Inc.** to lead the development of Tantramar's new **Corporate Plan**. The Corporate Plan will translate the Strategic Plan into operations utilizing available resources to ensure success of our long-term vision and goals.

Climate Action and Sustainability FCM Climate Adaptation Funding – Council committed \$12,700 toward the development of a Climate Change Adaptation Plan, unlocking funding through the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) Green Municipal Fund. This investment supports Tantramar's ongoing leadership in climate resilience.

# DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that electric power first came to Sackville in 1900 — two years before the cities of Moncton and Fredericton, and five years before Saint John? In that year, the power was supplied by a gasoline generator and ten years later, the system had grown to two generators. By 1927, a new transmission line was built between Amherst and Sackville and the local utility began buying power from the Maccan, N.S., coalfired power plant.





#### 211 New Brunswick

A 211 caller was struggling financially, having to choose between paying for their diabetes medication or food. They were also behind on utilities. They were a homeowner, so were not eligible for certain financial benefits.



The Service Navigator was concerned about the caller, especially because they needed essential medication. They offered to make a follow up call to ensure that the caller had received all of the assistance they needed. The caller agreed, and a time was arranged for the follow up.

When the Service Navigator made the follow up call and asked how everything was going, the caller responded: "everything is fantastic; you changed everything". They had gotten their medication, the El appeal succeeded, and they had accessed the EFB. When you're not sure where to turn to find the help that you need, remember that help starts here at 211. 


